If you have forms with you can I have them.</p> <p>Charlie went through what teams clubs have. We want fixtures up this weekend so we can start on the 20th weather permitting.</p> <p>Referees - we made a decision that they will be qualified for mini soccer this season. We are putting on a course this sat 10 -12 at the Sporting club. The league is covering the costs for this so please get anyone interested along. "Will a qualified ref get preference over the ones who have only done 2hr course?" We are a development league and we are also here to help develop future referees, if they don't ref they won't gain any experience. I will make a list of qualified 11 a side refs for the web site.</p> <p>We have had a meeting with the sporting club for a few reasons the main one being the Respect campaign which is being introduced by the FA. There will be a line pointed around the perimeter of the pitches, <b>NO PARENTS OR SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED OVER THIS LINE.</b> "Can we have a different colour than blue" - we will ask.
